*Software version 4.4 and above has PNG autotrace for PNG files that have a transparent background. It will automatically trace/add cut lines around the edge of the design.

** If a PDF was created as a vector, it may have cut lines. If it was created as a raster image, it won't have cut lines.

*** Embroidery files are technically cut files but they are not really meant to be cut with Silhouette Machines as-is.
